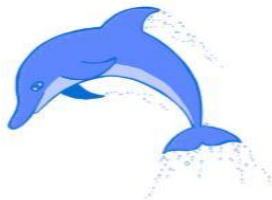

## District Goals

### What is Title I?

Lake Ridge Elementary is identified as a Title I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA, 2015). Title I is designed to support State and local school reform efforts tied to the challenging State academic standards to enhance efforts to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support family engagement. All Title I schools must jointly develop with all parents and families a written parent and family engagement plan.

### School Plan for Shared Student Achievement

#### What is it?

This is a plan that describes how Lake Ridge Elementary will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning.
